Information about personal data processing

In accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (...), hereinafter referred to as “GDPR”, the Jagiellonian University hereby informs that:

Personal data controller

The Jagiellonian University in Kraków, ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków is the personal data controller.

Purpose and legal basis for data processing

- Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of university admissions and for the purpose of fulfilling legal obligations by the Jagiellonian University. Article 6(1)(c) of GDPR is the legal basis for data processing. Legal obligations arise from the Law on Higher Education and Science Act (Dz. U. of 2018 item 1668 as amended), its secondary legislation, and Jagiellonian University internal legal acts.
- Within the scope of the consent given for the personal data processing, the legal basis for the processing will be Article 6(1)(a) od GDPR.

Period of data archiving

- Your personal data will be archived for 6 months after the admission had closed, and it will be subsequently erased and deleted.
- Within the scope of the consent given for the personal data processing, your personal data will be processed until you withdraw your consent.

Data recipients

- Entities authorised to receive your data based on the general provisions of law, as well as entities cooperating with the Jagiellonian University and providing services to the Jagiellonian University based on personal data processing agreements, may be the recipients of your personal data.
- If you are not admitted, the recipient of your data will be the company providing correspondence services—for the purpose of delivering the letter of denial of admission.

Data processing rights

You have the right to:

- obtain information about personal data processing and about rights granted by the GDPR,
- access the content of your data and to its rectification,
- erasure of your personal data from the administrator’s system (unless further processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims),
- restriction of processing, portability, object to its processing—in situations described in the GDPR and in accordance with conditions specified therein,
- within the scope of the personal data processing based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, which will not affect the processing performed before the consent had been withdrawn, by sending an email to the following address: rekrutacja@uj.edu.pl.

In order to exercise your rights, you should submit an application in writing to the Data Protection Officer to the following address: Uniwersytet Jagielloński, ul. Czapskich 4, 31-110 Kraków, or by email to: iod@uj.edu.pl.

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes the provisions of GDPR.

Obligation to provide the data and consequences of not providing it

- Providing the university with your personal data is voluntary, but its processing is necessary for the university to complete the procedure of admission, and to fulfill legal obligations by the Jagiellonian University.
- Within the scope of data processing based on the consent, providing the data is voluntary.

Your personal data will be stored for the period resulting from the general provisions of law, in particular Act of 14 July 1983 on the national archival resource and archives and from the Ordinance of the Prime Minister of 18 January 2011 on office instruction, consistent itemised file lists, and instructions on organizations and scope of operations of company archives.

Your personal data is processed in accordance with Article 6(1)(e) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation). The legal basis for your personal data processing is the Resolution No XXI/231/11 of the Kraków City Council of 6 July 2011 on establishing prices and fees for transport services, eligibility for reduced fees, and tariff regulations for Kraków city transport realized in the territory of the Kraków Municipality and Cities and Communes which had signed the intercommunal agreements on local public transport, appendix no 3 (Legal Journal of the Małopolska Voivodeship item 2011.363.3101, as amended).
